Renuka escapes from a brothel in Delhi in the middle of the night, takes the name of a Hindu goddess and goes into hiding in a north Indian community of sex workers. There, she meets the much younger Devika, who dreams of becoming a rapper. However, Devika is condemned to continue the tradition of her caste as a prostitute.

A tender but forbidden romance grows between Renuka and Devika - conflicts are inevitable. The two women overcome huge hurdles and make great sacrifices on their way to freedom. Eventually, their situation leaves them no other choice, so that murder is also a means of defence.

This suspenseful thriller shows individuals on the margins of society and allows an insight into a fragment of Indian culture.

Anasuya Sengupta received the Best Actress Award of all films in Cannes.
